Important

Limitations of this Risk Assessment

This Risk Assessment is concerned with general use of Garners Field campsite by non specified groups and is concerned only with general safety and does not consider maintenance, specialised activities, large gatherings or general camping. Risk assessments should be carried out by the leader or person in charge of each activity and should submit a copy to the Warden on arrival and ensure all assessments are on site and kept for inspection if no warden is present.

This risk assessment should be read in conjunction with the current site rules and for scouting activities the current rules listed in POR (Policy Organisation and Rules).

The management committee endeavour to provide a safe environment for booked activities to take place, it is the user who is responsible for their own assessments to ensure safety during their stay and activity.

Each risk assessment should take into account the nature of the activity, numbers of people involved, any special needs of participants, weather conditions and other people who may be on site.

General Information

The campsite comprises of a seven acre mainly level field adjacent to the river Wey with individual camping areas located around the periphery. The whole site is a natural environment with associated trip hazards. A large central open grassed area is provided for both camping and communal use. An activity centre, toilet block and other permanent storage buildings are located as per the plan below. Provision for Archery, shooting, climbing, tomahawks, water activities and other scouting activities are also located on the site.

Recommendations

All site users are to complete their own Risk Assessments and consider factors such as:

- number of people on site
- weather conditions
- time of day
- Other users on site
- Any event happening on adjoining property

Consider extra control measures

- Providing traffic marshals on lane and in parking area for large events
- The wearing of high visibility clothing when marshalling or walking on approach road
- Provide pedestrian escort for cars on camping area

Important Note

First aid kit and access to emergency telephone is only available when the Activity Centre is in use.

Recommendations

All site users are to complete their own Risk Assessments and provide their own First Aid provision considering factors such as:

- Nature of activities being undertaken
- Number of people involved
- Access to an emergency telephone and suitable First Aid Kit
- Mobile telephone with good signal

Recommendations

Garage area and gas storage area

This area should be separated with a physical barrier from the general camping area as hazards could be present from stored materials and equipment which might not be obvious to general users when doing their own risk assessments.

Prohibition signs should be erected to inform that the area is for authorised personnel only.

Consideration needs to given to access archery store, gas storage etc.
